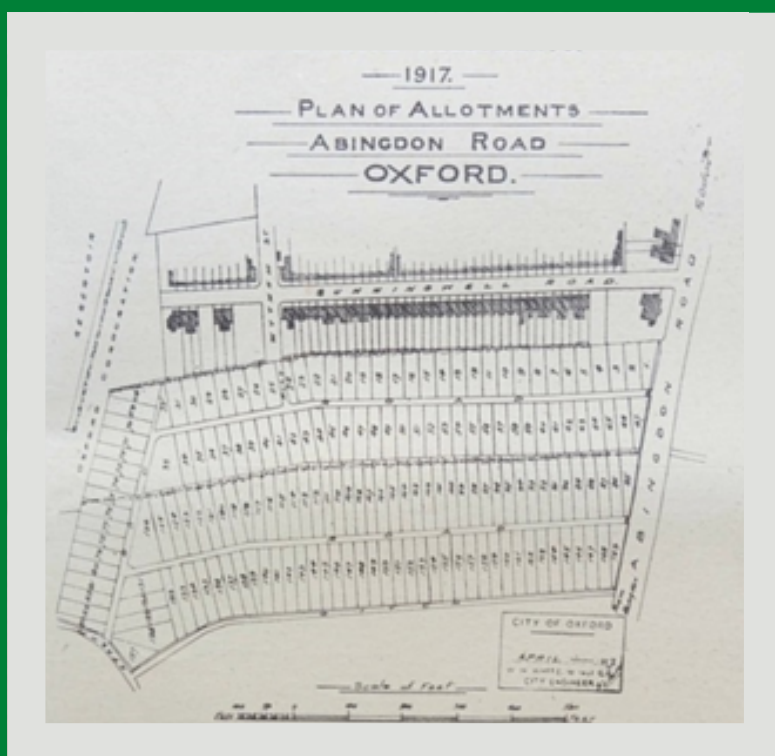


Stone Plant Markers

Make your own plant and seedling markers for your plant pots, garden or allotment.



Growing food has been important throughout times of national hardship. Many of the allotments in Oxford were created during the first and second world wars. This plan of the Abingdon Road Allotments from the city archives dates back to 1917.

1. Find a few light-coloured stones to decorate.
2. You can either draw straight onto the stone or you can paint the background a light colour. This will allow the pens to appear more vibrantly.
3. While you are decorating your stone, make sure to leave a space for the writing or choose light colours which you can write on top of.
4. Finally, you can write your plant type on the stone and place it in your garden or allotment.
